# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

#### I. Date and place:

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**INTERFILMLAB 8.0** (hereinafter referred to as the **Project**) is a training programme for the young film industry, taking place from **14 to 22 September 2024** in Olsztyn, Poland.

#### II. Objectives of the Project:

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The main objectives of the **Project** are:

- 1. to explore the potential for international collaboration among the younger generation of filmmakers from Ukraine, Georgia, Hungary, and Poland;
- 2. to implement a non-formal industry education programme for young directors and screenwriters, producers, distributors, sales and PR managers, demonstrating how to prepare a film project to increase its chances of success in the international film market;
- 3. to exchange best practices from different countries and initiate actions to promote international co-production collaboration;
- 4. to provide young filmmakers with up-to-date knowledge on how the international film market works and how to increase the export potential of national cinematographies;
- 5. to develop the skills of young film industry representatives in personal branding and effectively promoting their own work;
- 6. to expand the network of cooperation among European film industries.

#### III. Organisers:

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- 1. All proprietary copyrights to the formula and the artistic concept of the **Project** are reserved to the FILMFORUM Association, hereinafter called the **Organiser**.
- 2. The **Organiser** gives the status of the **Co-Organiser** to the Institute KOSMOPOLIS Science, Culture and Education Foundation.

**§**4

The **Organiser** gives the status of the **Partners** to the following institutions:

- a) Cinemahall INGO (Ukraine),
- b) Foundation for Art Development AIA (Georgia),
- c) Budapest Cultural Centre (Hungary),

as the entities which make important contribution to the preparation and realisation of activities of the **Project**.

**§**5

**Project Producer** (appointed by the **Organiser**) and **Project Coordinators** (appointed by the **Partners**) are in charge of all aspects related to the preparation and proper conduct of the **Project**, and have the decisive vote in disputes not included in the **Regulations** or requiring additional interpretation.

## IV. Terms of participation in the Project:

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1. The terms of participation in the **Project** are exclusively defined in these **Regulations**. Any promotional materials or advertisements are of informative character only.





Registration for participation in the **Project** implies unconditional consent to the rules outlined in these **Regulations**.

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The **Project** is intended for people from **20** to **29** years old coming from Ukraine, Georgia, Hungary or Poland (hereinafter referred to as the **Participants**). The **Participant** is obliged to submit the **PARTICIPANT'S SURVEY** to the **Organiser** along with:

- 1. a short motivation letter in English;
- 2. a short description of the film project the Participant would like to make.

§8

The **Participant's** task will be to develop a film project in an international group and to prepare a presentation for the final pitch meeting.

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To participate in the **Project**, the **Participant** is obliged to send correctly completed electronic version of the **Participant's Survey** to the **Organiser** until **2 September 2024**.

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Registration process for the **Project** takes place in the following manner:

1. The **Participant's Survey** must be correctly completed on the website:

https://wamafestival.pl/interfilmlab-8-0-participant-survey

- 2. After completing and submitting the **Participant's Survey** on the website, the generated PDF will be delivered to the email address given in the **Participant's Survey**.
- 3. At the recruitment stage, no paper documents are required to participate in the Project.
- 4. The Organiser is not responsible for the Participant's Survey that are not submitted on time.

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- 1. Participation in the **Project** is free of charge. The **Organiser** provides all qualified **Participants** with:
  - a) catering (breakfasts and lunches),
  - b) accommodation in double or triple rooms from 14-22 September 2024,
  - c) international travel,
  - d) free entry to all events covered by the **Project's** programme.
- 2. The **Organiser** warns that the majority of events will be conducted in English.

§12

The **Participant** accepts full responsibility for the correctness and truthfulness of information provided in the **Participant's Survey**. Providing false, illegible or incomplete personal information or not providing them at all, results in exclusion from participation in the **Project**.

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- 1. The number of places for the **Participants** is limited.
- 2. The **Qualification Committee** consists of the **Partners'** representatives. The **Qualification Committee** will select the **Participants** qualified for the **Project**.
- Decision whether the Participant was qualified or not will be send to the e-mail address given in the Participant's Survey.
- 4. Information on qualification results can also be obtained by phone after 5 September 2024.

#### IV. Rules of order:

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§14

In matters not covered by these **Regulations**, the provisions of the Civil Code, the Act on Copyright and Related Rights and other generally applicable laws shall apply.

#### §15

#### The **Participant** has the right:

- 1. to take part in all events covered by the **Project's** programme;
- to contribute their own propositions to the **Project's** programme;
   to receive assistance from the **Project's** staff;
- 4. to have their views and beliefs respected;
- 5. to have their own freedom and private space respected.

#### §16

#### During the **Project**, the **Participant** is obliged:

- 1. to attend all classes (lectures, meetings, practical exercises and accompanying events) covered by the **Project's** programme;
- 2. to be on time for the classes and meals;
- 3. to take care of their own safety and that of other **Participants**;
- 4. to behave in accordance with the principles of personal culture, respect the personal views and beliefs of other **Participants**, supervisors and lecturers:
- 5. to respect other **Participants**, supervisors and lecturers;
- 6. to respect the freedom and private space of **Participants**, supervisors and lecturers;
- 7. to recpect the guiet hours in the accommodation;
- 8. to maintain cleanliness in the spaces where the **Project** will be carried out;
- 9. to comply with internal order regulations for the Project's spaces, as well as the rules of use the entrusted equipment.

#### §17

- 1. The **Project** is an undertaking aimed at equal treatment and inclusion of representatives of communities with fewer opportunities, as well as promoting gender equality and tolerance for ethnic, cultural and ideological diversity in the European audiovisual industry.
- 2. Any manifestations of discrimination, disrespect or violation of the personal autonomy of **Participants** will be treated as a gross violation of these **Regulations** and may result in disciplinary relegation from the **Project**.
- 3. All cases of violation of the **Regulations** may be reported to the **Project Coordinator** with the right to anonymity and discretion.

## §18

## The **Participant** is prohibited from:

- smoking, possessing or consuming alcohol or using other psychoactive substances;
- 2. using physical or psychological violence against the others.

# §19

- 1. The Organiser is not responsible for the valuables and devices brought by the Participant to the **Project** or damaged, lost or stolen luggage.
- The Participant accepts financial responsibility for any damage caused by the Participant's fault during the **Project**.
- 3. The Participant must inform the supervisors of project groups about leaving the place of accommodation after 10.00 PM.

- 1. All presentations, photographs and video materials made during the Project are the property of the Organiser, Co-Organiser and Partners and will be made available under the terms of the "free

The Participant consents to promoting the results of the activities carried out as part of the Project by placing a presentations, photos, portfolio, jingle or other audio-visual work (including all film material made as part of the **Project**) promoting the mission and educational objectives of the **Project** on TV and radio stations, audiovisual publications and on the Internet.

#### §21

- 1.   - h) transmission of exerpts in TV programme announcements,
  - i) granting further sub-licenses to the partners and third entities.
